## Virtue of Recitation of Baqarah Chapter

From the Book, Tafsir e - Nemonah:

The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.) was asked: "Which one of the Quranic verses is the best of all? He said: "Chapter al - Baqarah"

Then he was asked: Which verse of Baqarah chapter is more superior? He replied: "Ayat al - korsi."

It is also reported from the Holy Prophet (S.A.W) who said: "If someone recites 4 times from the beginning of Baqarah chapter, Ayat al - korsi, two verses after it and 3 verses from the end of it, his property and life will not be hurt and the devil cannot come closer to him and he will also never forget the Quran." As cited in the commentary on Abu al - Fath Razi:

Abu Amameh reported from Abi ibn Kab who narrated from the Prophet (S.A.W.): "There is a hump for everything and the hump of the Quran is Sura al - Baqarah." Sahl ibn Saeed reported from the Holy Prophet (S.A.W.) who said: "Whoever reads chapter al - Baqarah in his house during a day, the demons cannot find a way to enter his house and whoever reads it during a night, he will be saved from Satan's evil - intention for 3 nights."

Barirah reported from the Messenger of God (S.A.W.)

who said: "Whoever learns chapter al - Baqarah, it will be the cause of his life blessing and whoever gives up reading it, it will be the cause of his regret and ill wishers will have no choice to read it."

Abi ibn Kab narrated from the Holy Prophet of Islam (S.A.W.): "No charity enters a house in which chapter al - Baqarah is not red; for it is the sanctity of the Quran."

As cited in the commentary on Majma al - Bayan:

"If one reads chapter al - Baqarah, he will enjoy Divine mercy and greeting and his reward will be like one who is anxiously monitoring enemy."

From the Book, Menhaj al - Sadeqin commentary:

"If he who reads Baqarah and al - Emran chapters, these two chapters will be two shadows to keep their readers from the sun of the Resurrection and in the world, he will be honored by people and in the Hereafter, he will attain higher ranks."
