- 2- The source of all feelings such as happiness and sadness.
- 3- The truth of human beings.

For (وأن) the following meanings are given in Persian dictionaries:

- 2- Human or animal soul.

In some Books, as in Sádi's "Rose Garden" (گلستان), (جان), and (روان) are used as synonymous words. In sufi, Moral and Philosophical literature (جان) and (روان) are taken to mean: a.(جان):

- 1- An abstract essence which is preceptive by nature and which has sway over the body.
- 2- (جان جان) (by Idafat) is used as the eternal soul whose place is in the heart of Perfect men i.e.a sufi.
- 3- All activities which come out of a living being.
